Paul and Gary Stanford of Les Stanford Chevrolet and Cadillac wanted to celebrate the life and passion of Zora Arkus-Duntov and as a result in 2010 they designed the Zora Arkus-Duntov trophy to be presented annually to the "Best of the Best" Motor City Corvette Concours invitees. The Show was held every September at the Dealership. Top winners from the major corvette shows throughout the summer - America's Corvette Club, Corvette Club of Michigan, Corvette Club of Windsor, Corvettes Legends Club, GMC

Corvette Set, Team Corvette, and V-8 Estate Corvette Club submitted approximately ten of the top cars from their shows and submitted them to the Motor City Concours Committee. This amounted to a total of about 70 cars. From these 70 cars a selection committee chose 30 cars to be invited to attend the Concours Show to vie for the Duntov Trophy. I was fortunate to be nominated for the Concours Show two times. (2013 and 2016) Enzo Carboni won the Trophy in 2013 with “Sexy Blue”. The show ran from 2010 to 2017.

Saturday, May 26, 2018 – Chatham Retro-Fest Car Show, Downtown Chatham.

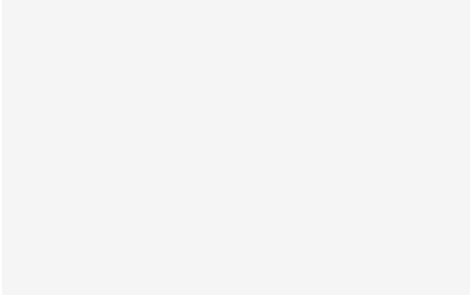

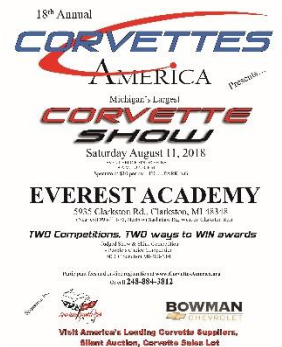

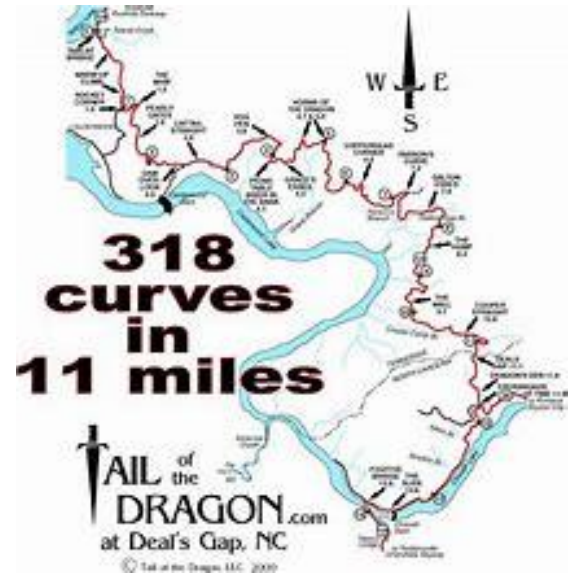

C6 Corvette is Wedged Under a Semi-Trailer in Tennessee

Check out these photos of a [scary accident](#) that happened Friday morning, March 26, 2018, on Interstate 24 West in Murfreesboro, Tennessee after a black C6 Corvette became wedged under a semi-trailer.

The crash occurred around 10:30 am at I24 West and the exit for the Joe B. Jackson Parkway and would shut down the interstate for hours as emergency crews rushed to the scene and worked to free the two occupants of the car.

Murfreesboro Fire and Rescue and Rutherford County's EMS Special Operations team were on the scene and they were able to extricate the Corvette's driver and passenger who were flown to Vanderbilt Medical Center via the LifeFlight helicopter.

A headlight bezel stacked on top of a Corvette tire and wheel sums up the story of a serious three-car crash in Poughkeepsie, NY around 11:30 a.m. Thursday.

A 57-year-old Highland Mills man lost control of his red 2013 Corvette Z06 as he headed north on Route 9, driving over the concrete median and crashing into a 54-year-old Hyde Park woman behind the wheel of a 2014 Jeep Cherokee headed south.

A tire then broke off the Corvette and struck a 2011 Toyota Camry driven by a 66-year-old Poughkeepsie man. The driver of the Corvette suffered serious injuries, and his passenger was also hurt. The Cherokee driver suffered non-life threatening injuries, and the Camry driver wasn't hurt.

By the time the occupants of the Corvette were extricated by rescue crews, the Vette wound up looking like a convertible, with the roof chopped off and being placed over the engine. The hood, meanwhile, was off and leaning up against the passenger side front fender.

Traffic in both directions on South Road (State Road 9) was blocked until about 3 p.m. while the crash was being investigated. Any witnesses to the accident are asked to call the Town of Poughkeepsie Police Traffic Enforcement Unit at 845-485-3680.

Starting with a C7, the firm took design cues from America's favorite sports car and rechristened the car as the Throwback. Equus describes the vehicle as the "ultimate American performance car" and has 1,000 horsepower under the hood to back up that claim.
